- A \$175.00 deposit is due at the time of application. Refunds will be issued, minus a \$50 administration fee, when notice of cancellation is received prior to **July 1<sup>st</sup>**. No refunds are issued after **July 1<sup>st</sup>** for any circumstances, and no reduction in tuition is given for late arrivals or early departures.

### Team Rates:
